Background:

United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) through its 4th Country Programme Action Plan “CPAP4” supports the Government of Islamic Republic of Afghanistan (GoIRA) in capacity enhancement in the areas of Population and Development Strategies, including data management and data utilization for policies and programmes aimed to reduce poverty, ensure every pregnancy is wanted, every child birth is safe, every young person’s potential is fulfilled and every girl and woman is treated with dignity and respect and every woman, man and child is enjoying a life of health and equal opportunity.

Introduction

Under the overall supervision of the Deputy Minister for technical affairs, the incumbent will directly report to the General Director of Policy and Result Based Monitoring of the Ministry of Economy, and UNFPA Program Specialist. She/he will play a lead and technical role in coordinating, ensuring integration of economic growth and development issues on national development frameworks. The Economic Advisor analyses trends in economic growth and development as well as the social and policy related environments in Afghanistan. S/he will have substantive role in the development of national economic growth policy/strategies in line with national goals and the post 2015 development agenda. The Economic Advisor will play a key role in supporting interventions to further advance and move the

agenda of economic growth and development into national policies, priority programs, strategies, plans and subsequent reports that are produced by the MoEc or the GoIRA for its internal use and for reporting to international and regional obligations. The incumbent has to strengthen capacity for development policies and strategies. The post holder should be willing to travel to field/provinces as might be required.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Under the overall guidance of the MoEc's leadership, the Economic Advisor will perform the following tasks:

- Collect information and data on macroeconomic indicators of Afghanistan's economy;
 - Assess the current status of national indicators and provide policy recommendation for economic growth and development;
 - Assist in development of an economic growth policy and strategies for the country;
 - Analyze data using mathematical models, statistical and econometric techniques;
 - Prepare annual report on economic growth, trade growth, and fiscal analysis;
 - Undertake relevant research and write reports on macroeconomic situation;
 - Develop economic guidelines and standards and prepare points of view used in forecasting trends and formulating economic policy
 - Deliver results within tight deadlines and in response to specific supervisor's request
 - Any other relevant tasks assigned by MoEc
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- Any other duties that might be assigned by the supervisor.
